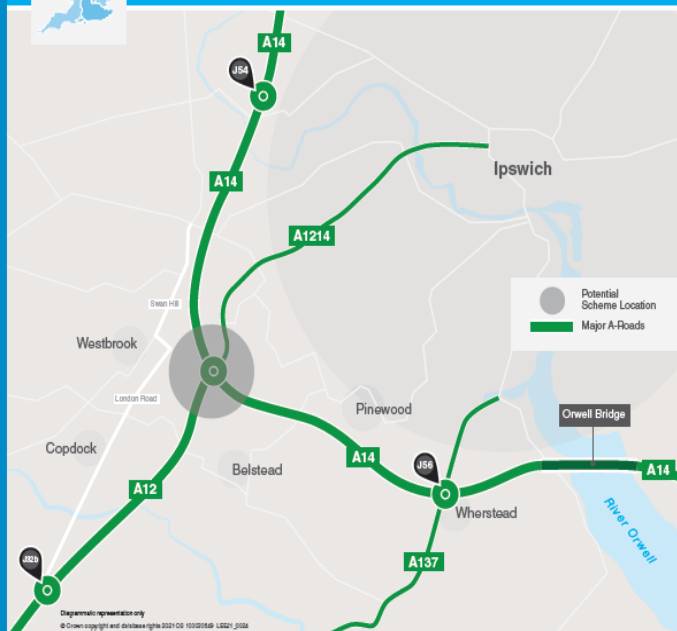

We will be hosting a number of events where you can come and find out more about the scheme and provide your feedback.

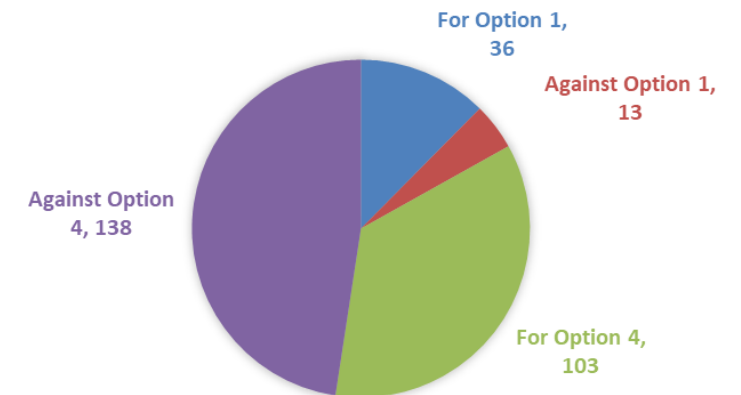

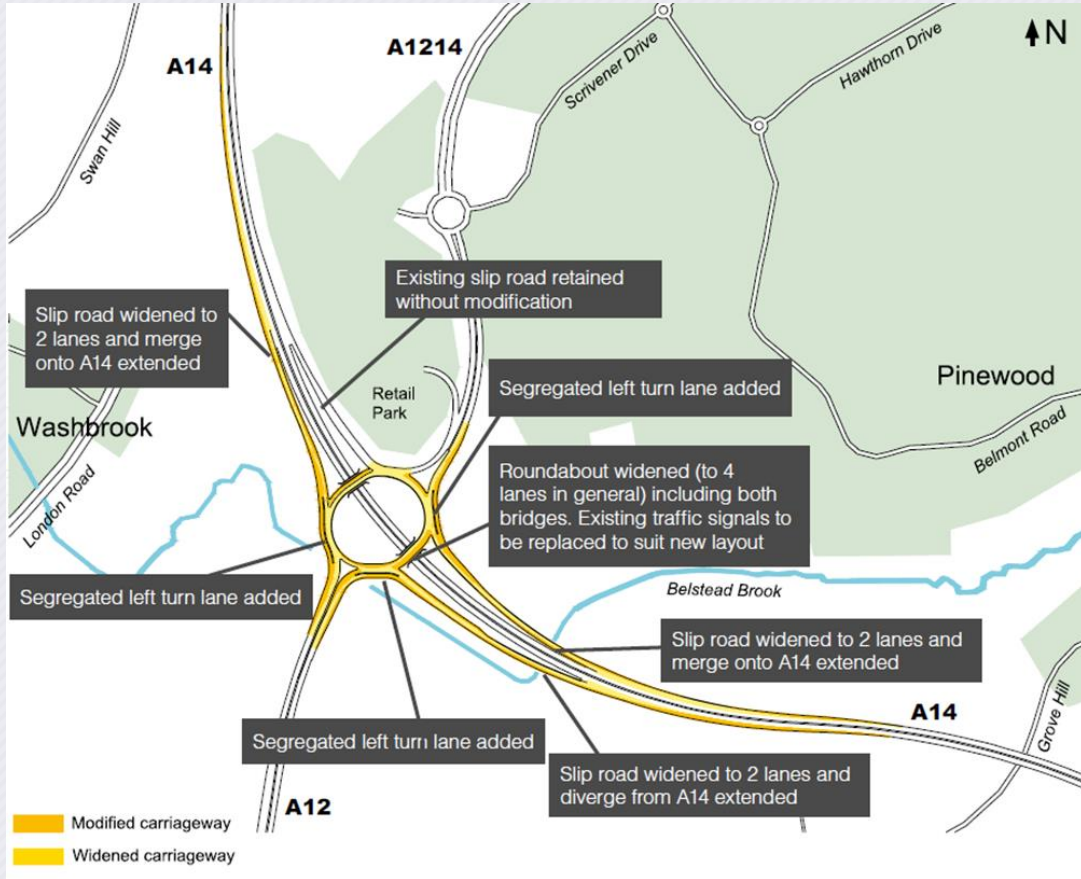

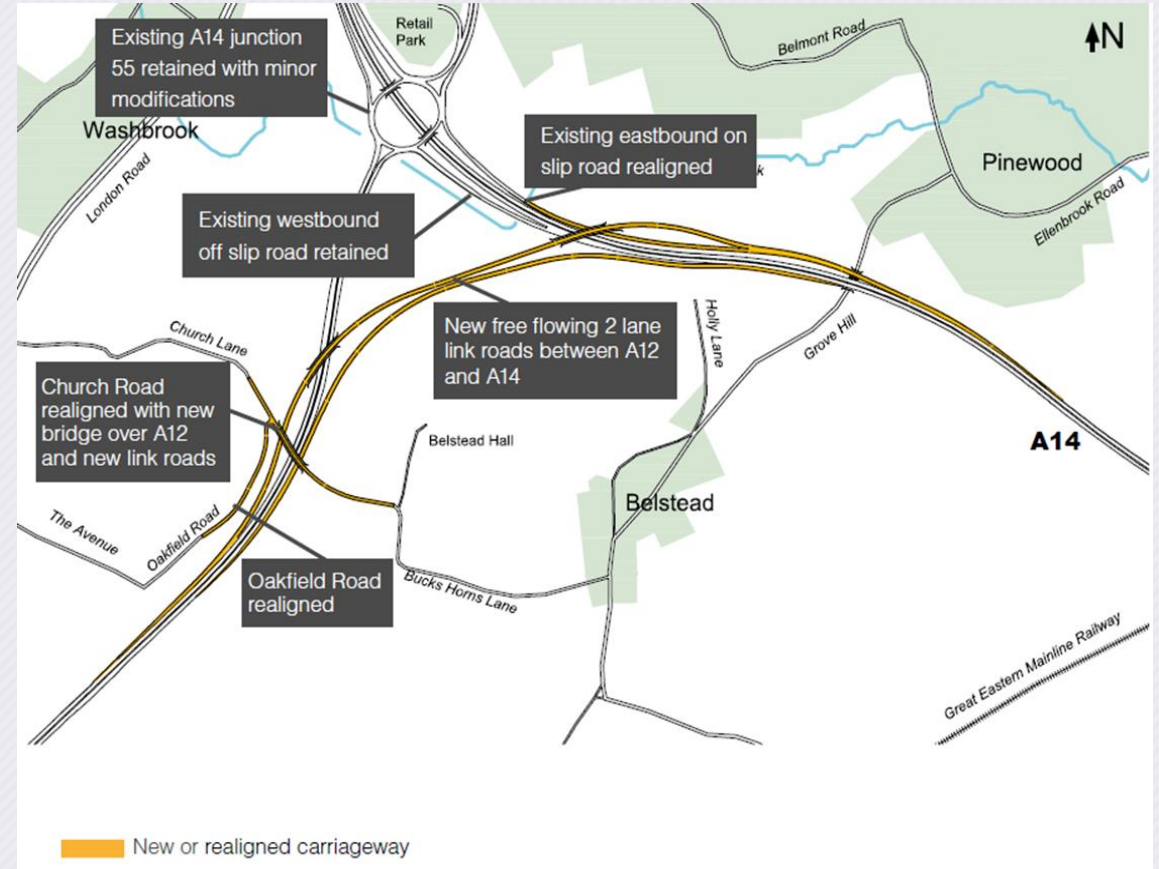


The Options

Scheme Development

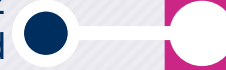
- Completion of all PCF Stage 2 Products, including Outline Business Case
- Cost profiles have been updated in the stage, including engineering feasibility reviews, scheme objective alignment, and environmental impacts analysed
- The scheme (should it go ahead), is likely to require Planning Act consent and would therefore require Development Consent Order approval from the relevant Secretary of State



Next steps

- The project has completed Stage 2. No further work beyond this point prior to any further approval from DfT
- We won't know which projects are committed for delivery in the third Roads Period until the RIS3 is published
- **Not all projects in the pipeline will be taken forward**
